
DISNEY IN DETAIL



Below are a few images I found in a Google image search that might help you find something else to collage your illustration together. If you're looking for an alternative to urban sketching details I suggest looking for patterns and replicating those patterns into your building blocks.





- CIRCLE/SEMI-CIRCLE x I
- SQUARES x 4
- TRIANGLES x 7
- RECTANGLES x 16





Left are the sketches I completed in Disneyland. You can see that not EVERY tiny detail was captured and some leave a lot to be desired. If you are urban sketching I think it's important to move quickly and not labor over anything too much. A huge part of the charm is seeing all the sketchy lines and I love the wonky perspectives. Photo references are great to capture if you plan on re-visiting your sketches and help to flatten your image (making it easier to draw reference from the perspective and lighting). Don't feel the need to draw everything either - if you just like the shape of an object, or the pattern painted on it, just sketch those parts. And remember... HAVE FUN!
