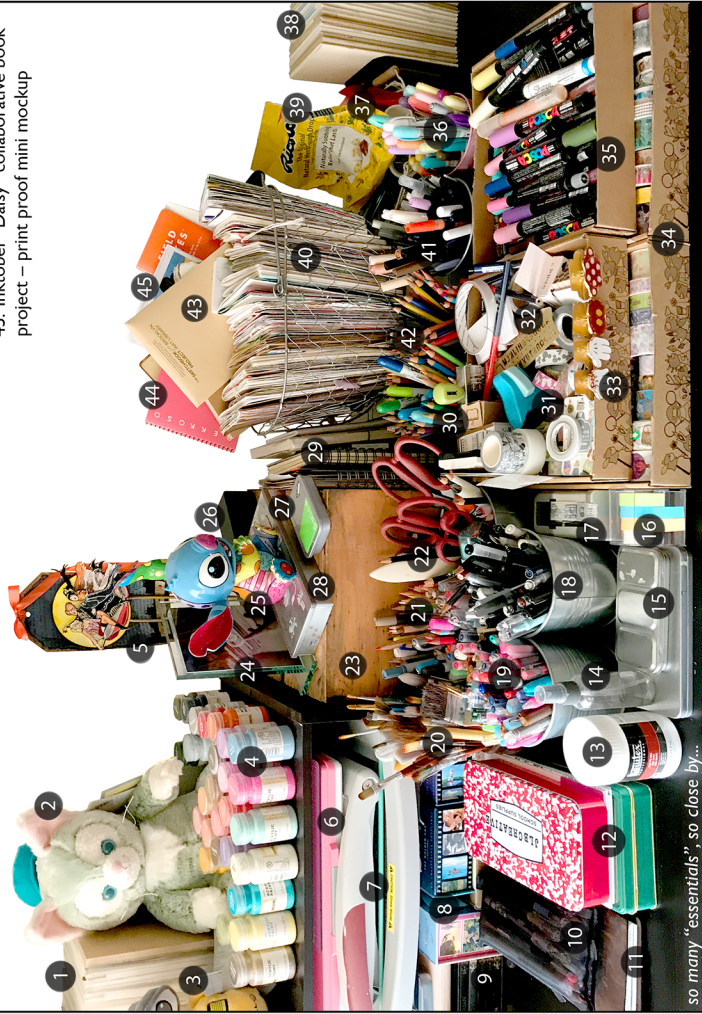


45 THINGS I CAN REACH FROM MY DESK
